COVID-19 Guidelines

On behalf of Tassajara Learning Center, we hope that your family is staying safe and healthy. We are committed to the health and safety of our teachers, children and their families. This page contains information on how we have been adapting daily to meet the needs of our children best.

Tassajara Learning Center is COVID CERTIFIED by the State of California Community Care Licensing Division. The following are guidelines that have been implemented since our reopening on May 18, 2020.

- All adults and children must sanitize hands before entering TLC, sanitizing station is available in front of school.
- The adult dropping off or picking up must wear a mask. Children under the age of 12 are not required to wear a mask
- School aged children will not be permitted inside TLC's facility at any time. Younger siblings must be in a car seat, stroller or held by parent at all times inside TLC's facility.
- Temperatures of all children will be taken upon arrival at TLC
- To maintain social and physical distancing, please allow one family at a time to enter classroom to drop off child/children and sign in/out.
- Disinfected pens are available in the "clean" cup, after use, pen must be placed in "dirty" cup.
- Adults are to remain in cubby area only during drop off/ pick up times
- Children will wash their hands in classroom upon arrival and multiple times a day
- Commonly touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected multiple times a day which includes lobby, classrooms, bathrooms and playgrounds.
- The facility will be cleaned nightly by a professional janitorial service

The health of our teachers, children, and their families is of the utmost importance to us. TLC will continue to take that duty seriously.
