COVID – 19 Guidelines

UPDATED, January 10, 2022

On behalf of Tassajara Learning Center, we hope that your family is continuing to stay safe and healthy. Again, we are committed to the health and safety of our teachers, children and their families.

- Check your child for symptoms daily. This includes fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough and fatigue. If symptoms arise, they must stay home to be monitored for 24 hours. If symptoms persist, your child will be required to test negative for Covid-19 before returning to school. If symptoms arise at school, your child will be isolated immediately and will be asked to go home. Per CDC guidelines, if your child tests positive, your child will be required to quarantine for 5 days, asymptomatic, and 10 days, with symptoms.
- All adults are required to wear a mask regardless of vaccination status.
- THREE families are permitted at a time to enter the classroom to drop off child/children and sign in/out.
- It is required that all adults sanitize hands before entering TLC, sanitizing station is available in front of school.
- Adults are to remain in cubby area ONLY during drop off/ pick up times.
- School aged children will not be permitted inside TLC's classrooms. Younger siblings must be in a car seat, stroller or held by parent at all times inside TLC's facility.
- Disinfected pens are available in the "clean" cup, after use, pen must be placed in "dirty" cup.
- Children will wash their hands in classroom upon arrival and multiple times a day.
- Commonly touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected multiple times a day which includes lobby, classrooms, and bathrooms.
- The facility will be cleaned nightly by a professional janitorial service
